This rhyming book is good but rather short. I read it to a class of EYFS and Year one children, who were all intrigued to see what he did next and if he would get caught. Some of the higher ability children noticed that it was a rhyming book. The book could be used in English to help children see different rhyming words. It could also be used in Creative Arts- there are many ways to create a scruffy dog picture/sculpture.
