Although underwhelming compared to other reads, *The Billionaire and the Con Artist* was cute, steamy, and surprisingly driven by emotion and backstory.

It was impossible not to tear through this one; it was cleanly written with quotable prose and thoughtful depth. The author played with the cliché billionaire and thief to make them something more than cardboard cutouts, which impressed me, because in a genre like this, it can be easy to get away with focusing on sex, rather than story. And this one managed to be mostly story, with attention to detail in the clockwork of, in particular, our hero and heroine. There were definitely cliché moments, and the ending was too tooty-frooty for me, but all in all, it changed my perspective on stories like this.

This is a guilty pleasure for lazy nights when you just want to focus on something light. It was (over)dramatic, engaging, and a whole lot of fun. Despite my three-star rating, I did really enjoy it, and I would recommend it to anyone relaxing with fresh paint on their toenails and an avocado mask on their face.
